# Parking and Carpooling

Parking at the Oregon campus is limited. Use of our alternative parking lot off Highway 26 at the Boring exit is highly recommended. We will have class buses shuttling from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm. You are encouraged to drop-off your guests at the campus, and then proceed to the alternate lot for parking and shuttle service.

Thank you so much for helping to make this event a success for both the puppy raising community and our surrounding neighbors.

**Directions to alternative parking at local church:** If you are traveling east on Highway 26, take the Boring exit and turn left over the freeway. The Church of Latter Day Saints parking lot is on the left (across from the gas station). If you are traveling west from the campus on Hwy 26, take the Boring exit, and turn right.

## DIRECTIONS TO THE OREGON CAMPUS

### Directions to GDB from the south:

#### *Going north on I-5:*

Take I-205 north. Take exit 12 and at the end of the exit ramp, turn right onto Hwy. 212. You will be going through an industrial area and several stop lights. Follow Hwy. 212 (and signs to Mt. Hood). Go through Damascus and then proceed into Boring. At the only traffic light in Boring, turn right onto Richey Rd. At the top of the hill go straight to the stop sign (the road also curves to the right, don't curve right!). Turn left at the stop, onto Kelso Rd. Travel approximately 2 miles and GDB will be on the left. If you come to Hwy. 26 you just passed it.

### Directions to the Guide Dog Campus from Airport:

Take airport Way (East) to 1-205 (South) to 1-84 (East). Continue on Hwy 84 east to the Wood Village exit. (Exit 16). Turn right onto 238th/Hogan. Continue approximately 3 miles on Hogan. Continue through several stoplights. After crossing Division, stay in left lane. Turn left on Burnside at next light near Coffee People & U-Haul. Burnside becomes Highway 26 heading east. Continue on Highway 26 approximately 7 miles, turn right on Kelso Road, go one block to the Guide Dog campus on the right.

### Directions to the Guide Dog Campus from Highway 84:

Take Hwy 84 east to the Wood Village exit. (Exit 16). Turn right onto 238th/Hogan. Continue approximately 3 miles on Hogan. Continue through several stoplights. After crossing Division, stay in left lane. Turn left on Burnside at next light near Coffee People & U-Haul. Burnside becomes Highway 26 heading east. Continue on Highway 26 approximately 7 miles, turn right onto Kelso Road, go one block to the Guide Dog campus on the right.

### Driving distance: From Guide Dogs for the Blind to:
